

AP European History

Summer Project 2020

Thank you for your interest in taking the Advanced Placement European History course. You will find this course to be challenging, informative, and rewarding. While a large portion of this class is geared toward learning material and skills that will help you pass the AP exam in European History, you will find that these skills will also benefit you throughout your high school and college career. Because there is a tremendous amount of material to cover, and a limited amount of time to cover it, the Summer Project is designed to give all of us a “jump-start” to the European history course.

Part I

- Read Chapter 11 “The Later Middle Ages: Crisis and Disintegration in the 14th Century” – You can access a PDF of the book and other materials by joining the AP Euro Summer Project Course on Schoology. (Join Code: **N2T7-QJ5R-5J4GN**) To join, go to Schoology Courses and click on “My Courses” in upper right corner, select “Join Course” and enter the code.
- Complete Chapter 11 Reading Assignment. Due to the Covid-19 school closure, this year’s summer project will be completed digitally. There is a Schoology assignment in the AP Euro Summer Project Course that you joined. Complete the Google Doc assignment. Answers do not need to be in complete sentences, unless indicated, but need to be as thorough as possible. Don’t simply “hunt” for the answers, read each section thoroughly before you begin the questions and write a complete answer, not just the first thing you see.
- This assignment should be submitted on Schoology by 8:00 a.m. on the first day of School, at the latest. If you submit the project early (see options below) you can earn extra credit.
 - Extra Credit Option #1: Submit t by midnight on Friday, July 31st for **10 points of extra credit**
 - Extra Credit Option #2: Submit by midnight on Friday, August 7th (the Friday before school starts) for **5 points of extra credit**
- **There will be a very short multiple-choice quiz on the first day of class on Chapter 11.** You will need your device for the quiz on the first day of school.
- **Due Date: Chapter 11 Reading Assignment due the FIRST DAY OF CLASS = 50 points**

Part II

- Study the countries of Europe. We will take the Map Test the THIRD week of school.
- You can use a map online to study or a quiz program like this one: https://world-geography-games.com/countries_europe.html (I also put the link in our Schoology Course)
- **Map of Europe Quiz (European Countries only) = 25 points**

*** Late work is only accepted for 1 day with a 20% point deduction!**

Extra Credit Opportunities:

- Besides the possible extra credit you can earn for turning in your Summer Project early, check our Schoology Course throughout the Summer for possible extra credit opportunities!

The summer project is necessary so you do not have to read an entire chapter the first few days of school. The assignment should not take much of your time, but you will find that by completing this assignment prior to our first day of class you will have a good introduction to European History and be prepared for a successful year in this course. I also listed the required materials for this course below so you can be prepared for the first day of school.
